BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL SYSTEMS

Please apply sunscreen to your child before school, now that the better weather is finally here and ensure they have a water bottle in school. There has been a steady stream (!) of parents dropping off water bottles and hats to the school office. Please ensure your child has these items with them at drop-off; staff cannot keep leaving the office to deliver items to children.

Please check that your child's uniform is named. We cannot return jumpers to children if there is no name!

All children with long hair **MUST** tie it back (plaits or a full pony tail please) this is to prevent the spread of head lice and ensure children can move around/play and learn without getting their hair in their eyes.

Please can I remind all parents that we do not allow scooters on the site before and after school, because of all the slopes and steps and the number of parents with young children, prams and buggies at drop-off.
