HEAD LICE

We have a reported case of head lice in Key Stage 2. Please check your child's head and treat if necessary. The easiest way to check is to get them to tip their head forward over a white bath or light-coloured sheet and comb all the hair forward using a very fine-toothed comb. You can then check for white 'dots' (eggs) glued to the hair shaft or see if any live lice fall out.
