## **SUMMER READING CHALLENGE (ASSEMBLY WILL BE ON WEDNESDAY 11TH JULY)**

The Summer Reading Challenge encourages children to get into libraries and helps them keep up their reading skills. It is the UK's biggest promotion of reading for children – last year, over 21,500 Hertfordshire children took part – and it's free!

Children are challenged to read six library books or e-books of their choice during the holidays. For every two books they read, they are rewarded with two stickers. When they have completed the challenge, they will receive a wristband and are invited to a presentation ceremony where they will be given their certificate and medal. In addition, participants will have the opportunity to win tickets to an exclusive author event.

Mischief Makers packs (inspired by the children's comic 'Beano') will be available in all Hertfordshire public libraries from **Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> July** while stocks last, finishing on **Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> September**.
