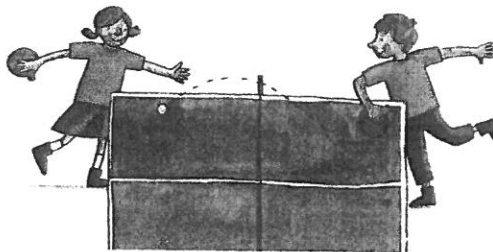


Mrs Gaskitt
