Year 6 – Nathan and Aahan always work independently on their work in all lessons and have supported others in the class on difficult challenges.

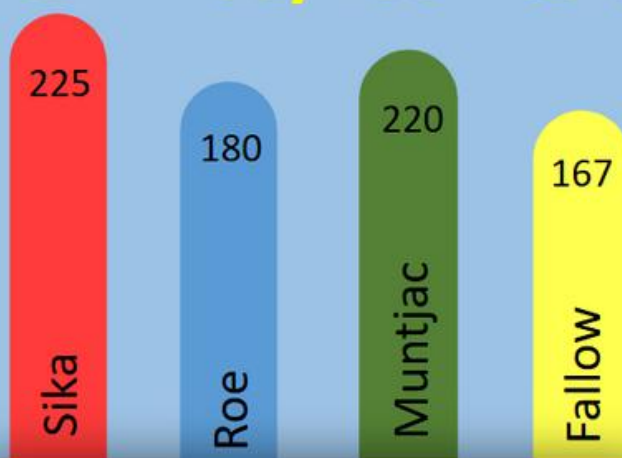
