PROGRESS FROM KEY STAGE 1 TO KEY STAGE 2

Progress is calculated using a value added measure from KS1 to KS2 in reading writing and maths:

- A score of 0 means pupils in this school do about as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A positive score means our pupils on average do better at KS2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A negative score means our pupils, on average, do worse at KS2 than those with similar prior
- · attainment nationally.
