Year 5 – Daniel always lights up the room with his beaming smiles, and is a very thoughtful friend. Noah is most effusive with his praise and is always supportive of


Year 6 – Gaheez has been supportive throughout the week with his friendly smiles and praise for others and Rahavi has helped her peers solve problems in a range of subjects.
