We have been using the iPads this month, learning how to select apps, return to the home screen, and play some simple games. This has been very popular in active learning.

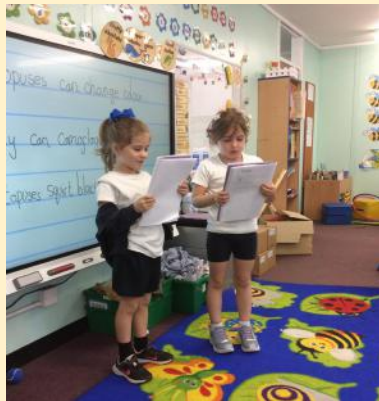
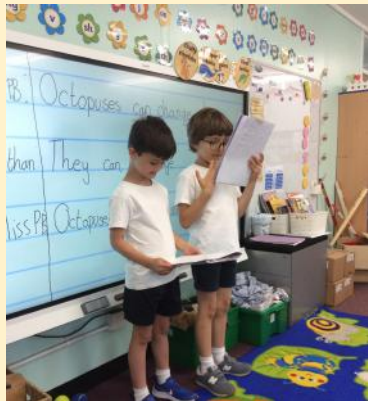
Miss FitzGerald introduced 'paired reading' and we have been enjoying reading with our Year 6 buddies on Wednesday afternoons.

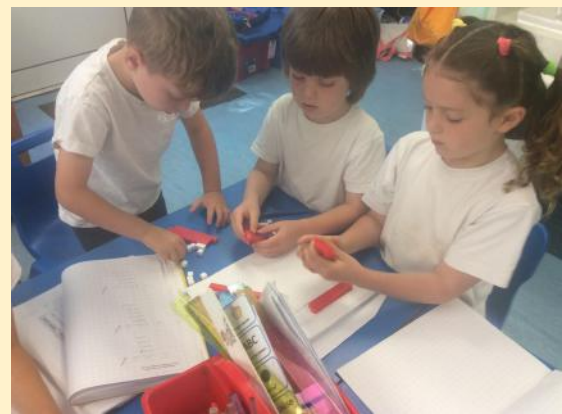

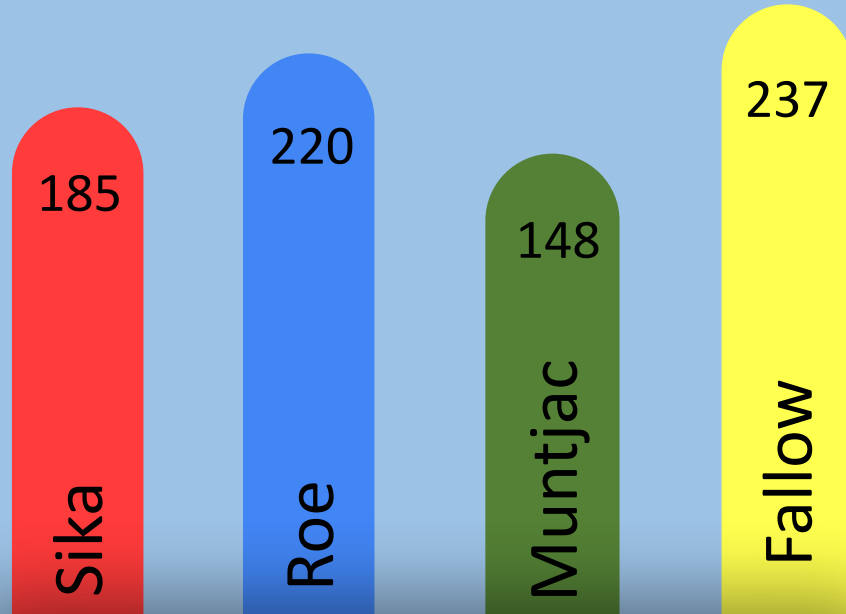
Year 6 – Olly is always an independent learner who solves problem and supports his peers with their learning. Ijahn always works on her net steps and works independently to solve difficult tasks.
