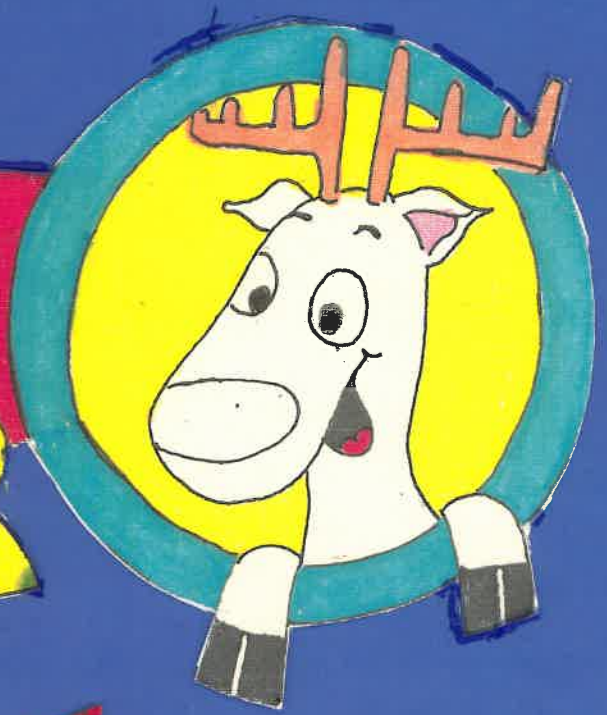

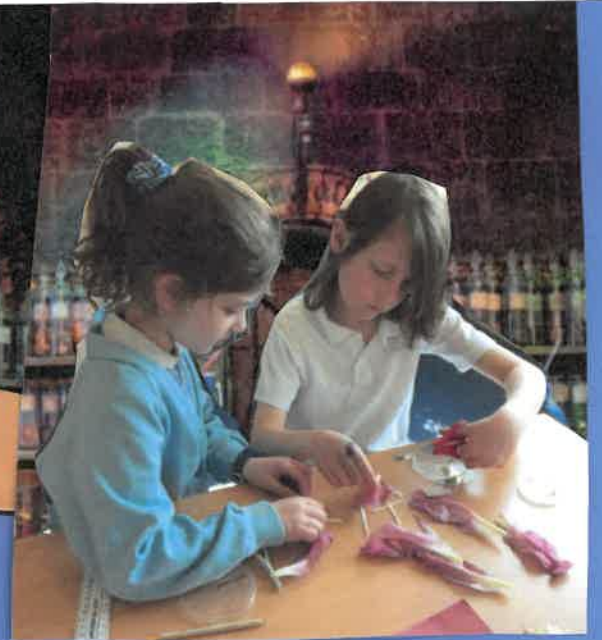

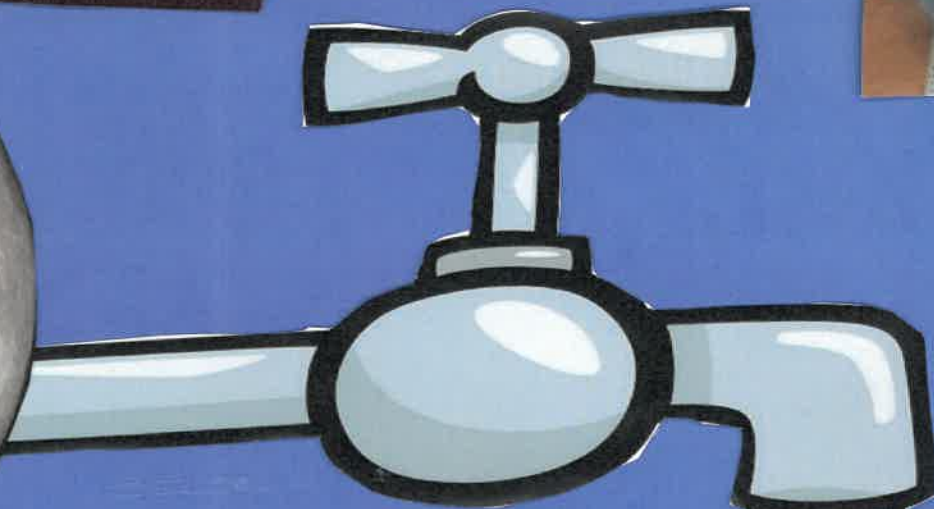
# YEAR 3 DISSECTED THEIR FLOWERS!

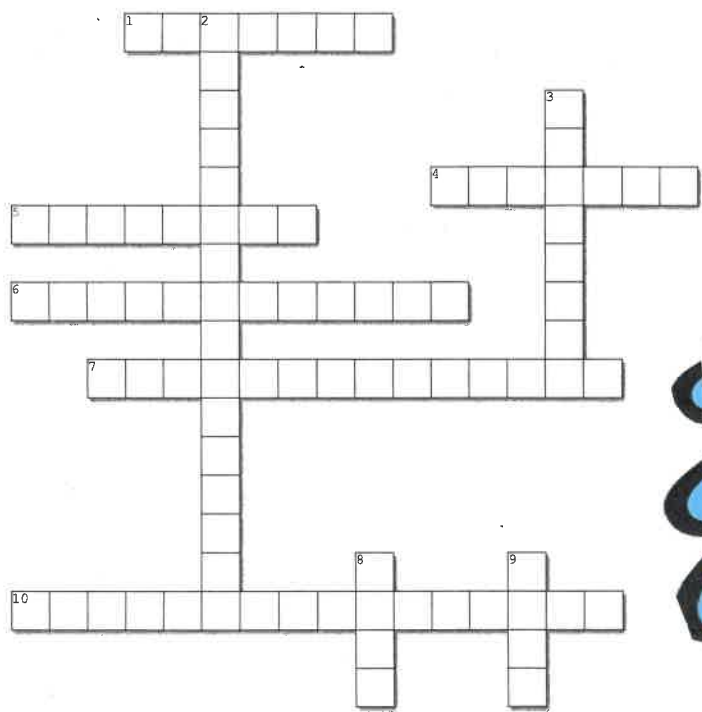

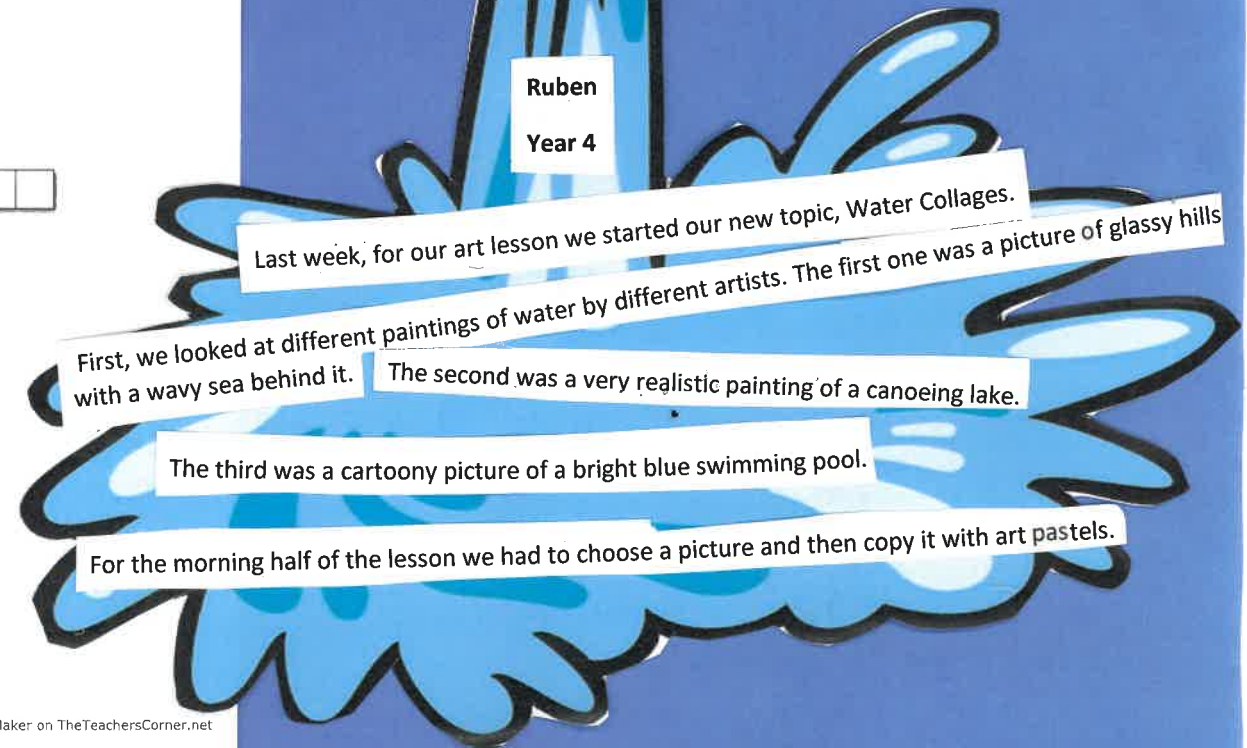
