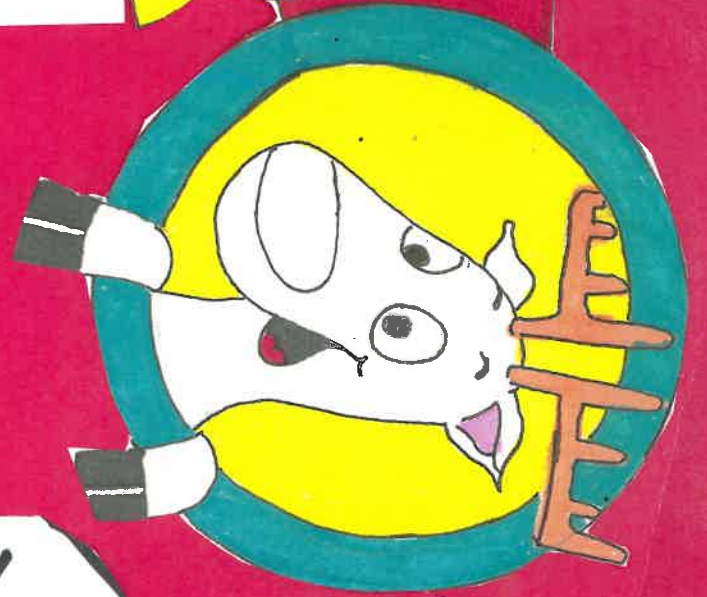

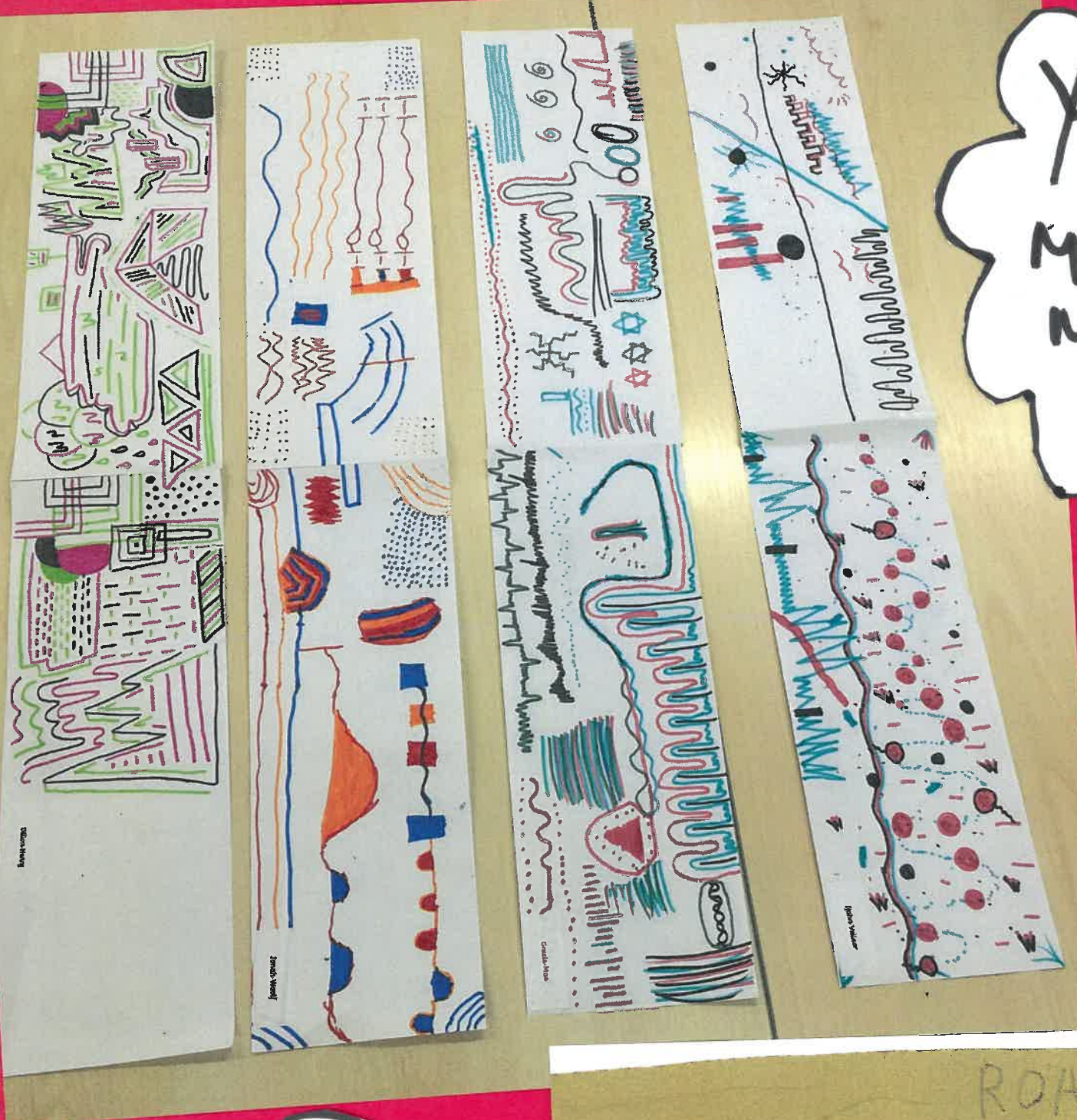
When I'm bigger, I want to do a profession where I would be able to help people, like Florence Nightingale did!

### Appearance

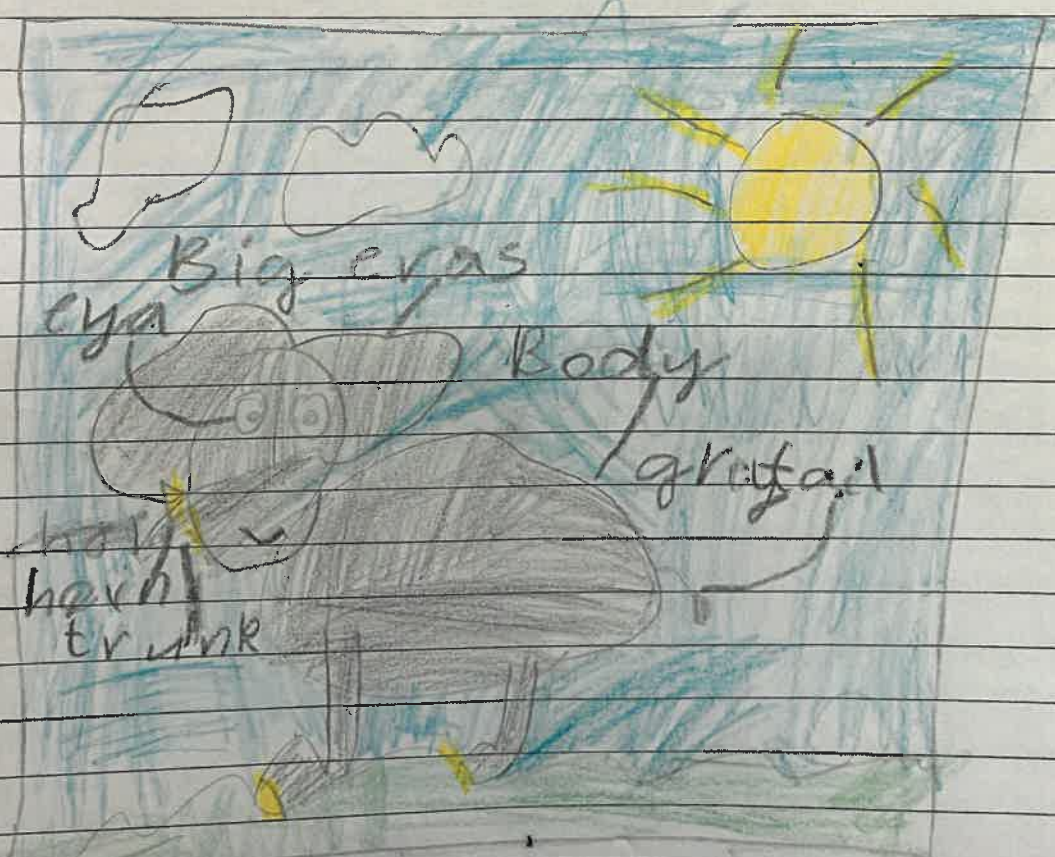
Elephants are grey. They have two horns on their trunk. They have big ears and have ~~small~~ small and grey tail and two eyes.

### Homes

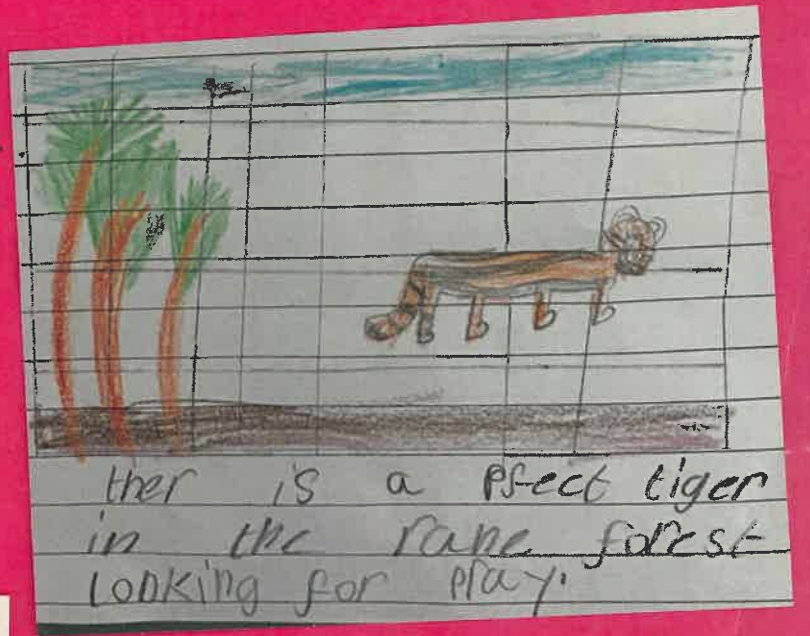
In the Stone Age, people were nomads which meant they were always on the move, so people built temporary homes like dens or lived in caves in the Bronze and Iron Age, people built first round houses then hillsorts made from wattle and daub which is mud and twigs. In the Stone Age, in the Neolithic period, the last period as the Stone Age, they made skara Brae in the Bronze Age, they turned into round houses, in the Iron Age, they turned into hillsorts, these were for protection.

### Tools and Weapons

In the Stone Age, they made their tools from flint stone and made their tools by flint napping which is banging two pieces of flint stone together to make tools in the Iron and Bronze Age, first they made tools from bronze by melting copper and tin then they started using iron and there was more as it so they started sighting metal and they made it with metal work. In the Stone Age, people used spears and axes but in the ~~Iron~~ ~~Age~~ Bronze Age, they still didn't have much weapons but in the Iron Age, they had lots of weapons so people caught more.
