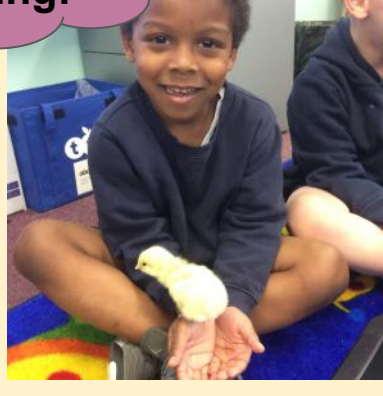

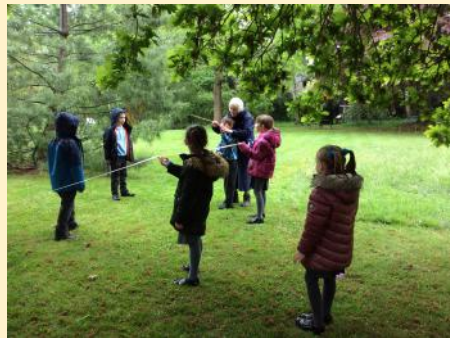

Year 5 – Gaheez has made lots of brave choices in his learning this week, as has Melisa. Both of them have been having a real go!

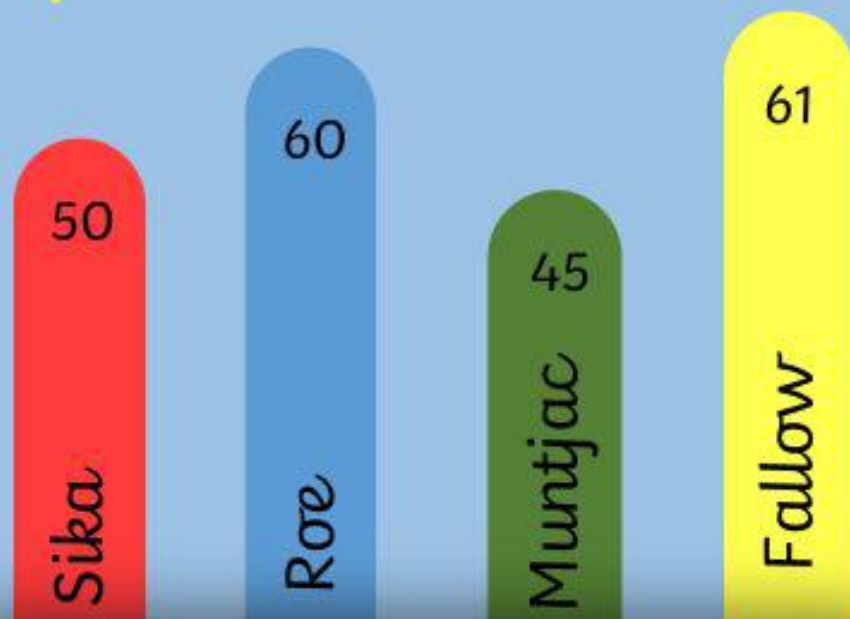
