We celebrated the King's Coronation! We made flags, crowns and badges with our own designs.

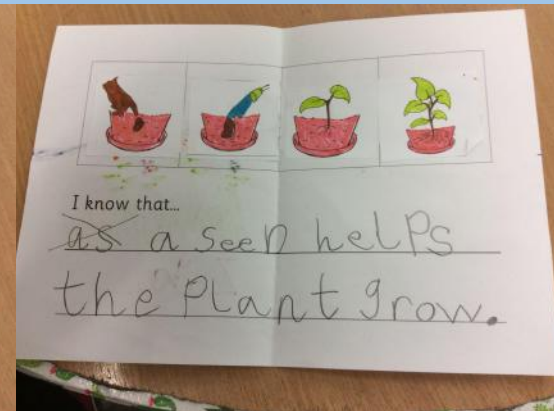


In the nature reserve, we used hammers to create the patterns of leaves on white cloth.

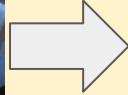

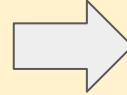
Year 3 - it was pizza-making month!



First we worked in groups...



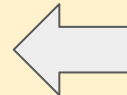
...and achieved a great first attempt!

We spent a lesson in the hall raising money for new iPads...and getting fit...and having fun... on a bouncy castle!



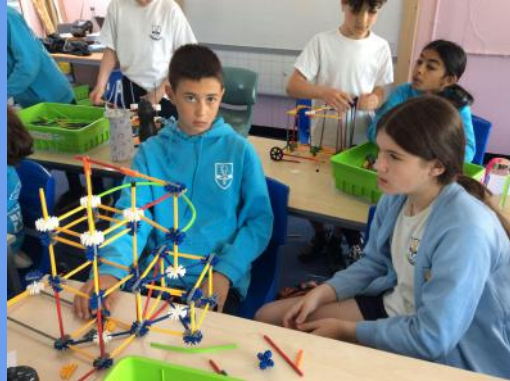


YEAR 5
