Year 5 – Edie always works well with a range of different partners, as does Tobias.

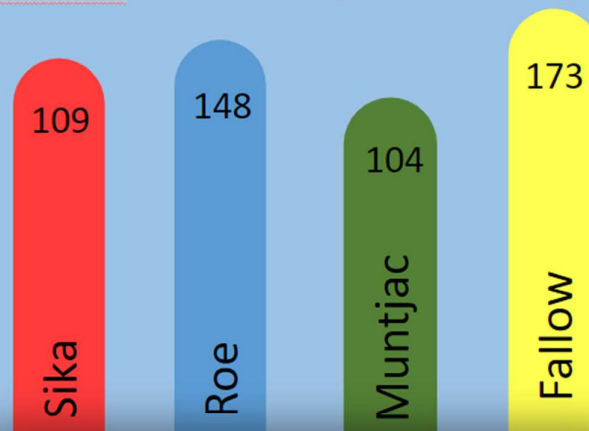
Year 6 – Megan has worked well with numerous partners offering advice and helping them understand the material. Dylan always works hard and supports others in the class.
