RE: OPENING FOR OTHER YEAR GROUPS: In a statement made in the House of Commons the Secretary of State for Education said that “the Department for Education continues to follow the best scientific advice and that this cautious, phased return of education and childcare settings is the most sensible course of action to take. While we are not able to welcome all primary children back for a full month before the summer, we are working with the sector on the next steps to allow schools that have the capacity to bring back more children in smaller class sizes to do so before the summer holidays. We will provide further details in the coming days.”

This is sad news, but the bottom line is unless we can have larger groups (therefore less distancing) our classrooms cannot accommodate any more children.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO NOTE: Some Year 6 children have been wearing necklaces and bracelets. Our rule about jewellery has not changed. For health & safety reasons, jewellery should NOT be worn. Stud earrings and a religious emblem on a chain are permitted. School trousers may be worn, leggings are not school uniform.

Why we ask you to keep your child with you in the morning: *This is to ensure your child sees you following all the rules that relate to transmission of COVID 19 and we reduce the risks that relate to first aid or even emergency hospital treatment to the lowest level. PLEASE help us with this by following all our protocols and home school agreements.*

The most important symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of any of the following:

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- A new continuous cough
- A high temperature
- A loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)
