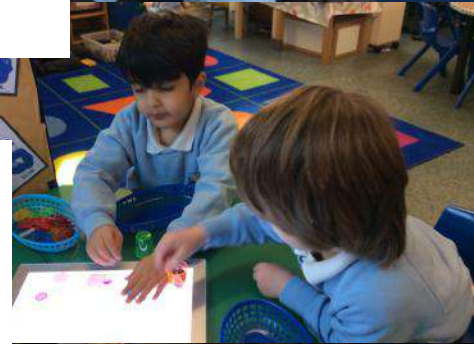

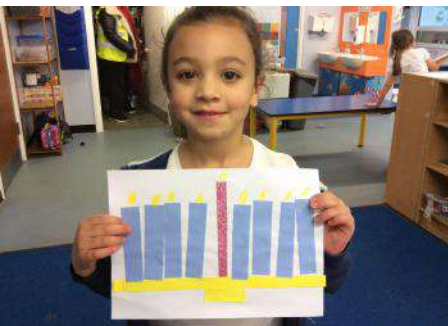


Reception

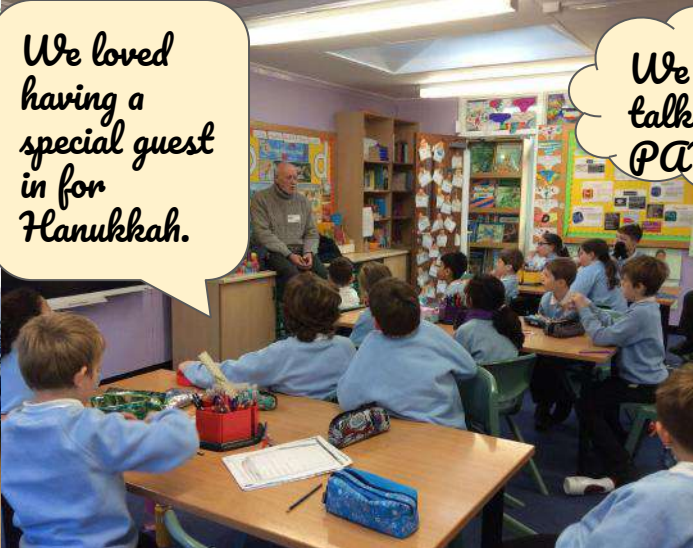

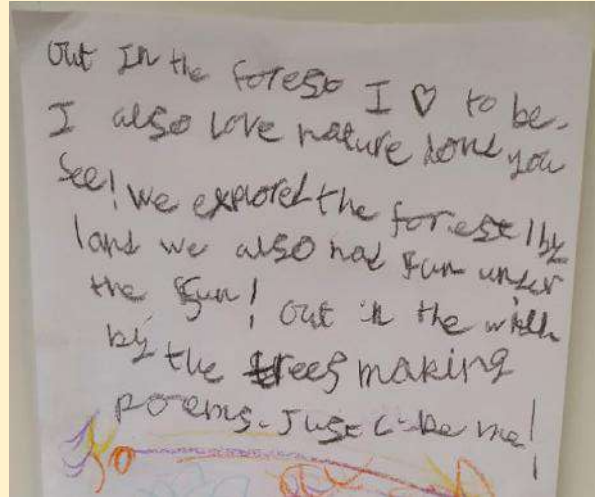


Forest School
