Year 2 – Sophia B shows great focus and always stays on task, and Mila listens well to peers and adults as well as being a supportive learning partner.

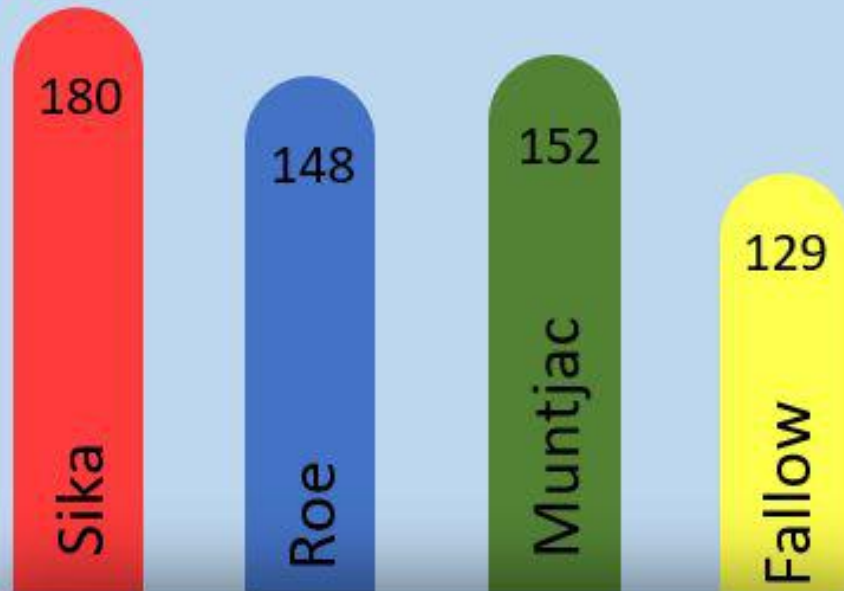
Year 3 – Sienna and Blake have shown some excellent listening skills this week and are always supportive learning partners.
