Year 6 had this unique opportunity to attend the amazing Disney theme performance of Purcell school orchestra at the Watford Colloseum.










### Forest School




## 5th November 2021 — Pearl: maintains good focus, stays on task, ignores distractions and listens well to both children and adults.
