
# Thursday 7th March

### Pencil Cases in KS2

We love the fact that the children come to school so well-equipped with stationery. It helps us to promote a sense of independence and organisation in the children regarding their belongings, which will serve them well at secondary school. It also means that we can funnel our budget into other resources that will support learning, rather than constantly supplying children with pens and pencils.

However, in some classes, the size and number of pencil cases has become an issue. Children should only have one pencil case and it should fit in their trays (which have a depth of roughly 10cm). Multiple pencil cases and the presence of unnecessary or huge amounts of stationery are creating distractions during lessons and, in some cases, damaging children's trays.

### Fidget Toys and Items from Home

We have noticed a large number of children bringing fidget toys to school without any prior consultation with class teachers. We are always willing to consider reasonable adjustments which enhance children's learning and we have seen a small number of children genuinely benefit from fidget toys or other such resources and have invested in them ourselves. Unfortunately we have noted that in the vast majority of cases they are causing distractions rather than their intended outcome of increasing concentration. If you feel that your child would benefit from using a fidget toy, please discuss this with their class teacher. Otherwise, children should not be bringing toys to school and we cannot be held responsible should they get damaged or lost.
