
School Spare Clothing and Request for Cagoules.

Year 6 – Seb and Ayaan are both excellent role models for listening to others and working collaboratively within pairs or groups.

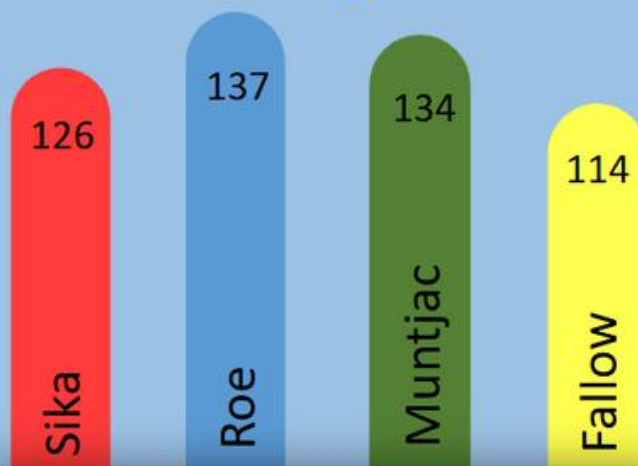
