
Year 4 – James is kind and supportive to his peers and Ta'Ziyah always has a positive attitude and is friendly to everyone.

Year 4 -St Alban's Catherdral Electric Umbrella Concert

On Tuesday 24th June, Year 4 will be visiting St Alban's Cathedral to take part in the Shine a Light Concert with Electric Umbrella and other Year 4 classes from Hertfordshire schools.

Year 4 will be part of Electric Umbrella's Super Group in the Nave of the Cathedral raising their voices together to shine a light on inclusion, celebrate differences and spread smiles.
