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
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HARTSBOURNE SPORTS WEEK - 10TH - 14TH JUNE

Year 5 – Yashil and Albie are both supportive peers, who are always positive and help others to solve problems with a smile.


Year 6 – Amelia always supports other people with a smile and friendly advice. Aarav has given praise to various other children this week helping them solve different problems.
