Year 6 – James has been challenging himself with tricky work all week being brave enough to have a go and Hanasa is supportive and kind to others in the class when they have made mistakes.

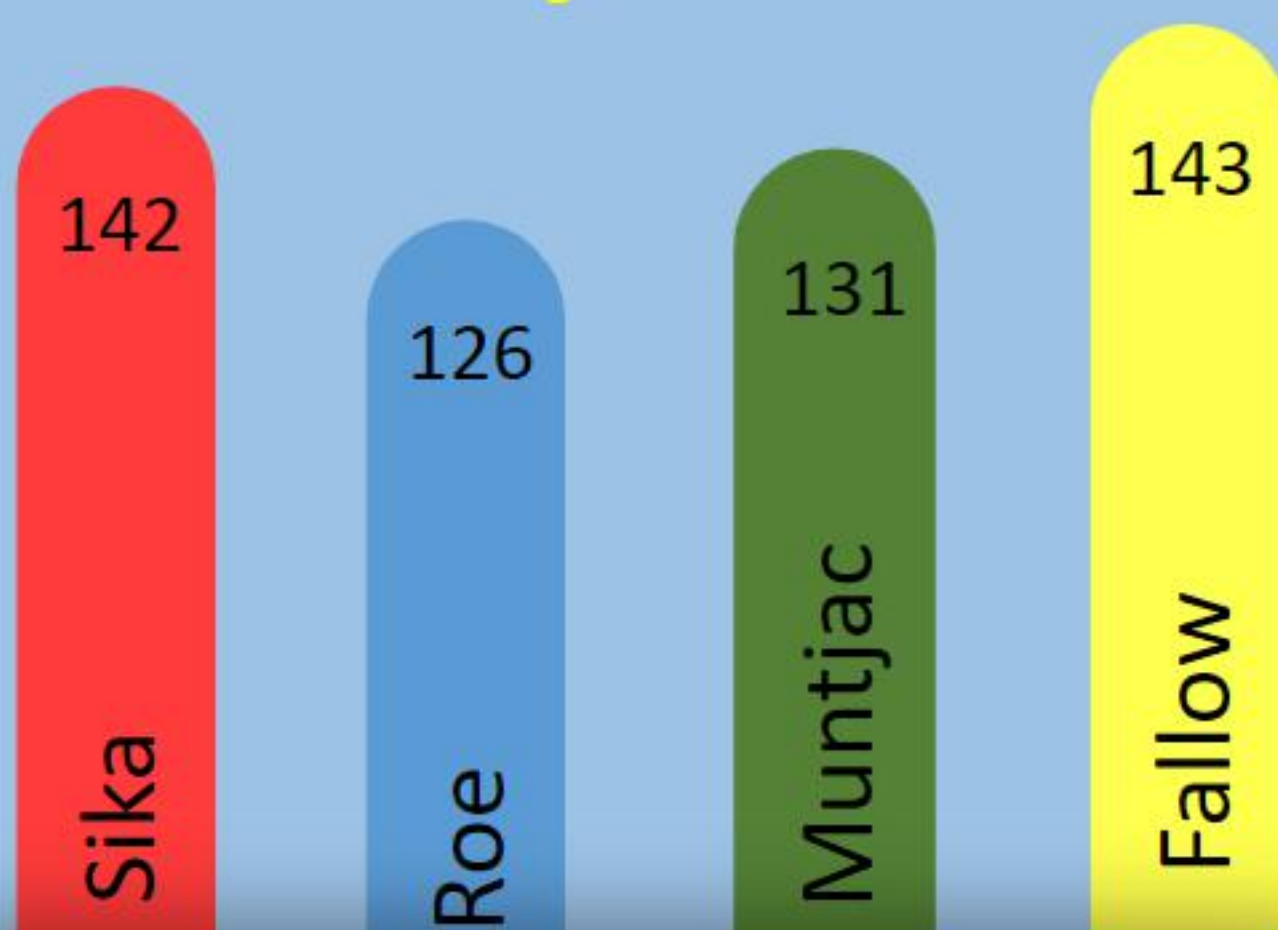
