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HARTSBOURNE HOOTENANNY



ATTENDANCE MATTERS

School plays a key role in children's development, and frequent absence from school also leads to gaps in your child's learning.

If a child's attendance was 95% last year they have missed 10 days of school. If it was 90% they missed 20 days of school. If their attendance was 85% they have missed 30 days of school.

Parents are legally responsible for ensuring their child's regular and punctual attendance.

We are aware of the high number of illnesses that have been around this term in particular and we're very grateful for your support in following the school /NHS guidance to reduce the spread as much as possible. We have no doubt we will see a noticeable increase in our attendance percentage as we go through the full school year.

Year 6 – Vivienne is always able to solve her own problems and works independently. Majid has been working independently throughout the week creating great similes and metaphors.

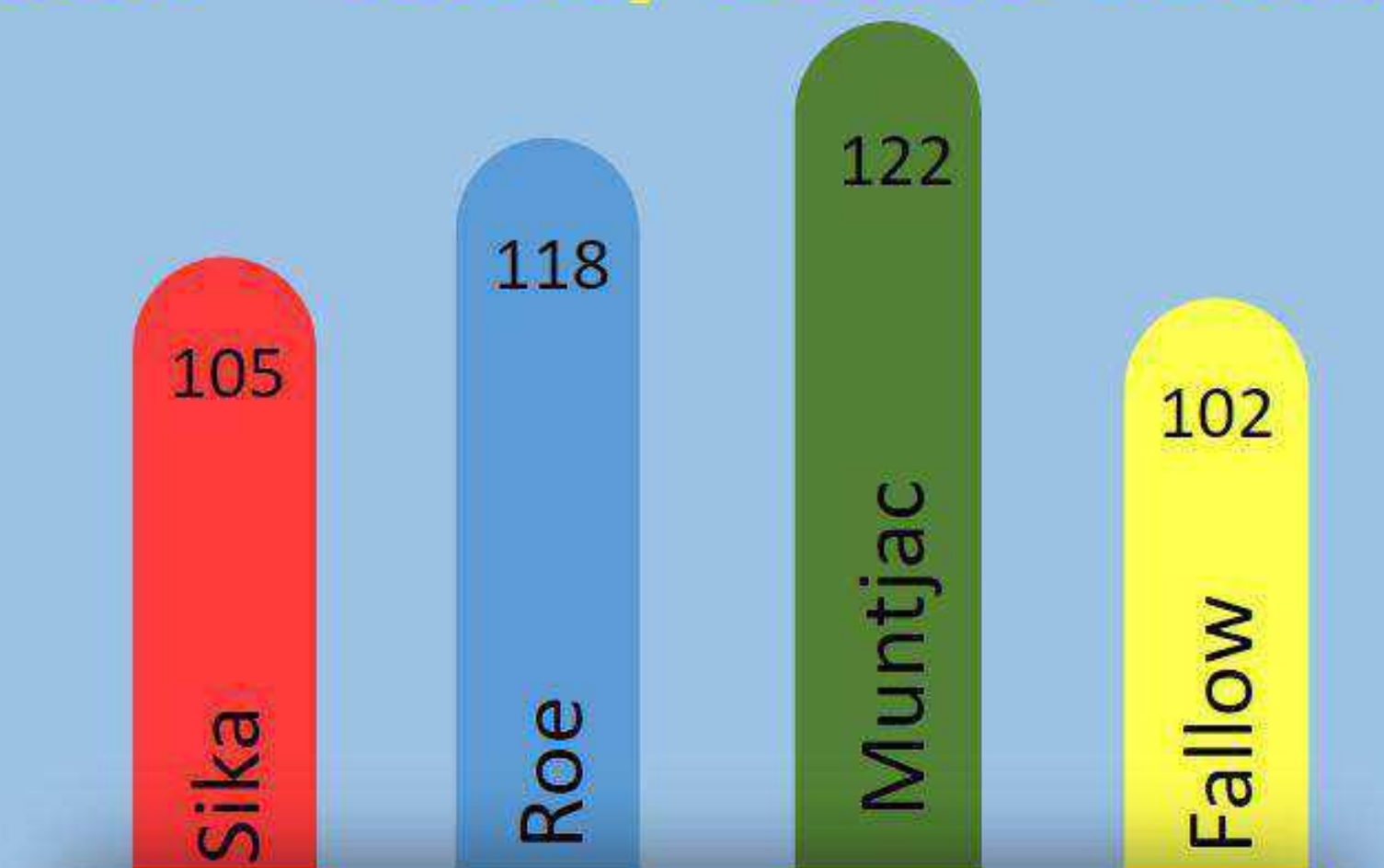
