6. Nigel goes to a cricket match with £37.81, buys a ticket for £12.78, a drink for £3.87 and a cake for £2.91. How much money does he come home with?
7. Kate buys her car for £450.32 but spends £34.89 on new wing mirrors and £67.98 on getting the brakes fixed. If she started off with £750.00, how much does she have left?
8. Andy's house-mate pays him £745.89 in rent but Andy has to buy food totalling £34.98 and pay the gas bill which is £128.95. How much does he have left from his house-mate's rent?
9. What is the difference between earning £3,478.01 a year and earning £2,981.99 a year?
10. Sammy loses £231.19 in an administration accident at the bank. His balance used to be £2,311.90. What is it now?
