Reception Home Learning Grid 1 – Spring 2020

These activities can be completed in any order and on any day; children should record something for each activity in their home learning book.

Communication and	l Language
(CL)	

Retell either 'The Gingerbread Man' or 'The Three Little Pigs' (both were covered in class last half-term).

Ask your grown up to video or take a photo of you retelling the story.

Challenge:

Make some puppets and act out the story using them.

Physical Development (PD)

Challenge yourself to see how many of the following you can do in 20 seconds (ask an adult to time you!):

- Jumps on the spot.
- Star jumps.
- Hops on one foot.
- Throw and catch a small ball or beanbag.

Challenge:

How long can you balance a beanbag or soft toy on your head without it falling?

Personal, social and emotional development (PSED)

Here are some jobs you can help with at home:

- 1. Setting the table for a meal.
- 2. Preparing your own snack, e.g. peel and chop a piece of fruit.
- 3. Making a sandwich, spreading your own butter and cutting it into pieces.
- 4. Wiping the table after a meal.

Challenge:

With your grown ups help, make a cake or other meal.

Literacy (L)

Read a favourite story and answer the questions.

What is the title?
Who are the characters?
How does the story start and how does it end?
Why is it your favourite story?

Challenge:

Think of an alternative ending to the story. Draw a picture and/or write a sentence about it.

Maths (M)

Go on a hunt around your house for 3D shapes.

What shapes did you find? What are their names? How many faces does each shape have?

How many edges does each shape have?
How many vertices does each shape have?

Challenge:

Make a tally of how many 3D shapes you found around your home.

Understanding the World (UW)

Choose your favourite country. Find out what the flag of the country looks like and draw or make the flag yourself.

What is the capital city of the country?
What language do they speak?
How do you say 'hello'?

Challenge:

Find out a 'fun fact' about your favourite country.

Understanding the World (UW)

Have a hunt around your home to see what technology you can find. Take a photograph or draw pictures of the technology you have found.

Challenge:

What is the technology used for? Can you write some labels for your pictures?

Expressive art and design (EAD)

Choose a favourite song and either make up a dance, or use some musical instruments to play along.

Ask your grown up to take a photograph of you.

Challenge:

Write a label or sentence to go with your photo to explain what you did.
