

1. **One mark** for explaining that prime numbers can only be divided by themselves and 1, and **one mark** for explaining that Daniel recognises them by their smooth, pebble-like quality.
2. **One mark** for mention of **all** of these three behaviours:
 - a. Eating exactly 45g of porridge
 - b. Counting items of clothing he's wearing before leaving the house
 - c. Drinking cups of tea at the same time each dayAnd **one mark** for explaining that Daniel becomes anxious, stressed or can't breathe properly if he doesn't follow his regular routine.
3. **One mark** for **any two** of the following:
 - a. Eleven is friendly
 - b. Five is loud
 - c. Four is shy and quiet
 - d. 23, 667, 1179 are big
 - e. 6, 13, 581 are small
 - f. 333 is beautiful
 - g. 289 is ugly
 - h. 117 is tall and lanky
 - i. 9 is immense
4. **One mark** for association of the word 'times' to multiplication, or numbers on a clockface.
5. **One mark** for explaining that the tall buildings in Times Square felt like 9s to him, and **one mark** for explaining that Daniel associates the number 9 with immensity.
6. **Two marks** for any answer that includes a **reaction** and an **explanation**. E.g. "I think it would be difficult [**reaction**] to live with savant syndrome because if someone affected my routine I would feel anxious or overwhelmed" [**explanation**].
