



Properties of blood



The 50 white stars represent the 50 states in the country. 13 stripes: the 7 red and 6 white horizontal stripes represent the original 13 colonies. Red colour represents hardiness and valor, white colour: purity and innocence and blue represents vigilance, perseverance and justice.
